## Some Words from the Wise

### Fr. Alfredo Villarreal

Dear JTD Community,

Grace and peace from God the Father and the Lord Jesus Christ. It is a joy to have this opportunity to share some words with you this month. On Wednesday, February 17, 2021, we began the season of Holy Lent with Ash Wednesday in the mist of an extreme winter storm. I hope all of you have recovered from any damage the storm may have caused.

Lent is a time of preparation, and in the Ash Wednesday liturgy we heard from [St Paul's second letter to the Corinthians](#), where he tell us, "[Behold, now is a very acceptable time; behold, now is the day of salvation.](#)" St Paul is asking the Corinthians and us to not take our salvation for granted, and to live each day as if it is our only day, that today is the day of salvation. St Paul also exhorts us, "[We implore you on behalf of Christ, be reconciled to God.](#)" This reconciliation with God that Paul speaks about is the work of forgiveness of sin that Christ accomplished for us on the Cross. For St Paul the purpose of Christ death was not merely to offer forgiveness of sins so one could just simply move on, but that it should reorient our lives completely towards God; that we would become ambassadors for Christ, no longer living for ourselves, but for Christ. Christ's sacrifice on the Cross was God the Father's and Christ's perfect manifestation of love for us, and this is what St Paul is referring to when he speaks of the "love of Christ." It is not so much the love we have for Jesus Christ, but the love Jesus Christ demonstrated for us on the Cross, and this love should be the motivation of our entire lives.

Lent is meant to help us remember "the love of Christ," the reconciliation he won for us, but how many of us go through lent and all our Lenten observances and then just move on. I encourage you not to let this lent just go by, but to live each day as if it is your only day, for today is the day of salvation. May we keep "the love of Christ" firmly planted in our minds, hearts, and souls so that "the love of Christ" may reorient our lives towards God and live as ambassadors for Christ each day, not living for ourselves, but for Christ; bringing His love, mercy, healing, peace, and justice to our families, friends, and community.

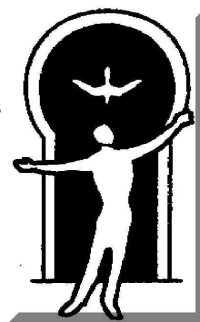
